

Rehabilitation Services

The Rehabilitation Services are offered to individuals with disabilities to obtain employment and live more independently through the provision of such supports as counseling, medical and psychological services, job training and other individualized services. Vocational Rehabilitation Service (VR) is the most commonly used rehabilitation service that is used by the Troup County School System. A yearly contract is signed with Department of Labor to access services offered by the VR agency. The VR agency offers the following services for individuals with disabilities: participates in IEP meeting as needed, offers transition services including rehabilitation counseling, evaluates students on career-readiness, provides vocational and or job-related training, assists with transportation and finding employment based on the interest, strengths, and abilities of the individuals. The transition facilitator in the Troup County School System serves as a liaison between the Troup County School System and the VR agency. The IEP team of juniors and seniors should contact the transition facilitator to involve the VR agency.
