Revocation of Consent

A parent may revoke consent for the receipt of special education and related services

once the child is initially provided special education and related services.

- Revocation of consent to provide special education and related services is for all special education and related services; not individual services.
- Parent must give a written notice to the IEP team or the special education director that she/he is revoking consent to special education and related services.
- Troup County School System will provide a prior written notice to parent before removing the student from special education program. Until the prior written notice is provided Troup County School System will continue to provide services.
- Use the revocation of consent form on the TCSS Exceptional Education website. That would serve as the prior written notice. Save that letter in the student folder.
- Once the parent signs the revocation of consent letter, the child is no longer eligible for special education and related services.
- Send folder to the appropriate records clerk at EEC.
